The itinerary and some information on the sites we plan to visit:

Dominican Institute for Oriental Studies:

(visit from 11:00 am - estimated to take 1.5 to 2 hours)

The Dominican library is considered prominent in the world of islamic studies, Arabic language, Quran exegesis, theology, law and jurisprudence, history, philosophy, sufism, science ... The library offers free consultation of its digital libraries. Our host is IDEO director:Jean-Jacques Pérennès, o.p.

His research fields have alternately covered development economics, interfaith dialogue and history of the Dominican Order in the Islamic world. After fifteen years teaching development economics at the University of Algiers (1978-1985) and in Lyon, at the Catholic University and at the Institute of Political Studies (1985-1992), he has been the assistant of the Master of the Dominican Order in Rome from 1992 to 1998.

He lives in Cairo since 2000 where he has successively been prior of the convent, general secretary and then director of the IDEO. From 2002 to 2010, Jean-Jacques Pérennès held the office of Provincial Vicar for the Dominican communities of the Arab world.

The Institute of Coptic Studies (معهد الدراسات القبطية) was founded in 1954 by its first president Professor Aziz Suryal Atiya, also the main editor of the Coptic Encyclopedia and the founder of the Middle East center, University of Utah, USA

It is housed at the St Mark Coptic Orthodox Cathedral in Ramsis Street, Cairo.

The Institute is the Egyptian Coptic church's main research centre and graduate school in a variety of subjects including Coptic music, Coptic art, Coptic iconography, Coptic language, Coptic theology, African studies, Coptic history, Coptic Architecture, Coptic Archaeology and Restoration and Sociology and Pedagogy

Several prominent coptologists taught at the Institute, including Mr Bahor Labib, director of Coptic Museum; historian Iris El Masry, Dr Ragheb Moftah, and iconographer Dr.Isaac Fanous.
